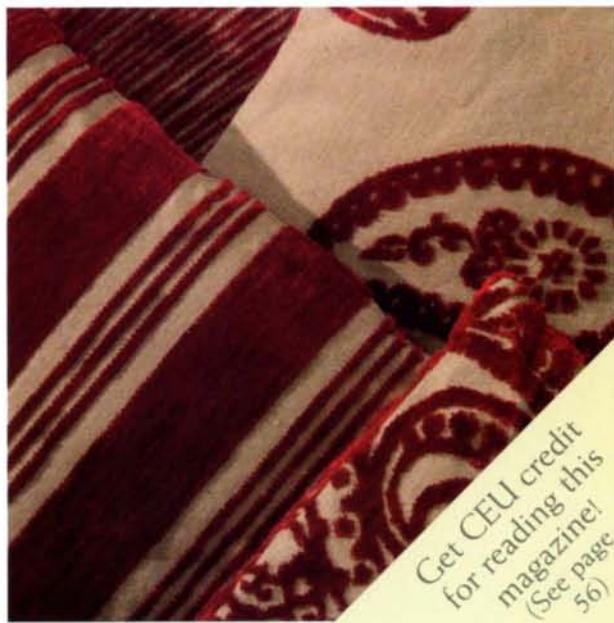

Susan Goldstick's Diva Armoire in the Tigress color scheme is actually two cabinets—the upper piece has three adjustable shelves and is painted on the inside—it works well as both a television armoire and as a storage closet.



This deco-style armoire is the first to be introduced to the Amy Howard Collection in three years. Made of solid alder, the Cherbourg Armoire features three exposed drawers, intricately detailed pocket doors with rounded sides, and a gilded harlequin design over macassar ebony veneers.



Inspired by designs of the Spanish colonial period, the stately Spanish TV Armoire from Revco International's Spanish Colonial collection features antique brass hardware and wrap-around doors.



The Armadio Corinzio by Artitalia is an exquisite armoire constructed of maple, cypress, and cherry woods. Its intricate inlays and diamond motifs come together to depict a medieval influence in the creation of this new antique.



This armoire from the Loire Valley collection by Scott Thomas features handwoven cane doors and finely detailed carving. Adjustable shelves and drawers are available, or the armoire can be outfitted with an entertainment option.



The armoire from the Bevan Funnell International Collection features double-hinged doors, enabling the doors to be folded back on themselves.
